- Willing to donate to any patient in need.



Manjot is a 9 year old boy and in his 4th grade. He was born in Windsor, Ontario. In March 2012, He was diagnosed with Aplastic Anemia. The doctors were unable to find a bone marrow match among Manjot's siblings. Immuno suppressive therapy, which is considered the alternative option for treatment, has not yielded positive results either. Manjot's doctor has initiated a request to find a bone marrow match from an unrelated donor for his bone marrow transplant. There is a better chance of finding a match in a South Asian Community.

Fewer than 25% of patients will find a compatible donor within their family. The remaining 75% rely on the generosity of others and a patient's best chance at a match is within their own ethnic group.

Manjot and over 900 other patients in Canada are currently searching for a match from an unrelated donor.
